Vt. gets \$1.2M broadband grant

MONTPELIER — Vermont's efforts to expand broadband Internet access have gotten a boost in the form of a \$1.2 million federal grant. The U.S. Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration announced the grant will pay for efforts to map what parts of the state have broadband, what parts lack it and what types of broadband are being offered.

Tom Evslin, the state's chief recovery officer, says the grant is a good sign that the state will be eligible for more federal funding to help get broadband service in areas that currently lack it.

All 50 states applied for the grants. Vermont is one of four winners.
