Our small town of Craftsbury (1100 people) is very rural, only state police 45 minutes away...

We started a Craftsbury Mental Health Resource Group, to help those navigate the mental health system in our small town, after my son's suicide in 2017. And also decrease stigma of mental health. We created a website www.nevtsuicide.com and booklet we hand out (also on website). My son was unable to get resources to help him in Northern Vermont.

We struggle trying to get training for our group and find resources to actually help those suicidal. Does the group have any suggestions. Although there are getting more recovery centers, there aren't any centers to help those suicidal that I know of. Any suggestions? Putting people in emergency rooms for the weekend, isn't a solution for many that are suicidal, at least my son...
